## DAILY READINGS

Welcome to the Gospel of Luke! We'd love for you to pick up an ESV Scripture Journal from church and use it to write down your prayers and answers to the reflection questions below. Before your reading each day, meditate on Luke 4:17-19 , pray for one person to know Christ  and one person to grow in Him .

### Memorization & Meditation:

17 *And the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was given to him. He unrolled the scroll and found the place where it was written,*  
 18 *"The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed,*  
 19 *to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." Luke 4:17-19*

### WEEK 1

#### Sunday, September 30th | The Gospel of Luke

- [Oct 1] Write out your answers to these two questions: Who is Jesus? What does it mean to follow Him? (save your answers and watch them grow in depth throughout your time in Luke)
- [2] Luke 1:1-4 | Google "Luke Overview" and read about Luke's 'orderly account'.
- [3] Luke 1:5-38 | Write out key details of the 'foretelling' of Jesus' and John's births.
- [4] Luke 1:39-80 | Spend extra time reflecting on Mary's and Zechariah's prayers.
- [5] Luke 1:1-4 | Luke wrote to one man (v.3). Who is one person that you could pour your life into for the sake of the gospel?
- [6] Review your notes from the week. What have you learned about the character of Jesus and how to follow Him?

### WEEK 2

#### Sunday, October 7th | The Gospel of Luke

- [8] Luke 2:1-7 | The son of God was born in a stable. What implications does that have on the way you view your current situation?
- [9] Luke 2:8-21 | What can we learn about sharing the gospel from the shepherds?
- [10] Luke 2:22-38 | What do we learn here about Jesus' mission (v. 30-35)?
- [11] Luke 2:39-52 | What do we learn about Jesus' uniqueness as both Son of God, and son of Mary & Joseph?
- [12] From the prophecies in ch.1-2, describe at least one way Jesus' coming affects your present life.
- [13] Review your notes from the week. What have you learned about the character of Jesus and how to follow Him?

### WEEK 3

#### Sunday, October 14th | The Gospel of Luke

- [15] Luke 3:1-29 | In what way is John's message 'good news' (v.18)?
- [16] Luke 3:1-14 | Using a dictionary if necessary, explain what it means to 'repent' of sin (v. 3).
- [17] Luke 3:15-22 | Summarize what John prophesied about He who was coming (v.16-17).

[18] Review Luke 3:1-17. How would the actions John urged help a person to 'prepare the way of the Lord'?

[19] The Spirit is described as a 'dove' and 'fire' – what does this tell us about His character & ministry?

[20] Review your notes from the week. What have you learned about the character of Jesus and how to follow Him?

### WEEK 4

#### Sunday, October 21st | The Gospel of Luke

- [22] Luke 4:1-13 | How did Jesus reveal more of His character through this temptation? How did He set an example for us?
- [23] Luke 4:14-30 | In what ways are you and those around you in need of the ministry Jesus announces (v.18-19)?
- [24] Luke 4:31-41 | Compare Luke 4:18-21 & 31-41. How were Jesus' teaching and action related?
- [25] Luke 4:42-44 | Jesus intentionally sought solitude. What habits do you have in your life that promote this?
- [26] Jesus says his ministry is to 'preach the good news of the kingdom of God'. What have we learned in chapter 4 about this Kingdom?
- [27] Review your notes from the week. What have you learned about the character of Jesus and how to follow Him?

### WEEK 5

#### Sunday, October 28th | The Gospel of Luke

- [29] Luke 5:1-11 | What about Jesus' miracle made Peter aware of his sinfulness?
- [30] Luke 5:12-27 | What did Jesus' willingness to actually touch the leper show about His character?
- [31] Luke 5:17-26 | How does this event re-affirm Jesus' identity as the Son of God?
