## DAILY READINGS

“Revive us” is a heart cry to the Lord for a renewed connection with Him. It is what happens when a follower of Jesus experiences a surge of Life and a church experiences an overflow of God’s presence into the community. In this series we will learn about the heart conditions that God is looking for as He responds in revival. We will then ask the Lord to shape our hearts and to revive us again! Before your reading each day, meditate on Psalm 80:19 , pray for one person to know Christ  and pray for one person to grow in Him .

### Memorization & Meditation:

“Restore us, O LORD God of hosts! Let your face shine, that we may be saved.” Psalm 80:19

### WEEK 1

#### Sunday, March 1st

- [2] 2 Chron. 17 | Jehoshaphat cleansed Judah of false worship and God blessed him. As you have walked with God, what idols has he brought to your attention that you’ve had to get rid of?
- [3] 2 Chron. 18-19 | Judges were called to judge “in the fear of the Lord, in faithfulness, and with your whole heart” (19:9). Ask God to help you grow in one of these areas in your own life.
- [4] 2 Chron. 20:1-12 | Jehoshaphat’s prayer reminds God of His promises to His people and calls upon His faithfulness. Write down some ways that God has been faithful in your life.
- [5] 2 Chron. 20:13-19 | Re-read v.15. Is there a battle in your life you need to surrender to the Lord in prayer? Spend time doing that today.
- [6] 2 Chron. 20:20-30 | What are the results of the battle in this passage? Reflect on the power of prayer demonstrated in this story.
- [7] Spend time today praying for revival to come in your own heart, in Antioch, in our nation, and in the world.

### WEEK 2

#### Sunday, March 8th (In Sunday)

- [9] Haggai 1 | What did repentance look like for the people of God in this passage?
- [10] Zechariah 1:1-6 | This is another call to repentance that ultimately leads to revival. What stands out to you in this passage?
- [11] Nehemiah 8:1-12 | The people spent days listening to the Word of God being read and were convicted of their sins as they heard and understood the scriptures. When was the last time God’s Word brought conviction in your life? Is God asking you to spend more time dwelling on his Word?
- [12] Matthew 3:1-14 | John the Baptist was preparing hearts for the revival that Christ was bringing. What was he calling people to do?
- [13] 1 Thessalonians 1:2-10 | God revived these new believers’ hearts for evangelism (v.8). What example can we take from them?
- [14] Spend time today praying for revival to come in your own heart, in Antioch, in our nation, and in the world.

### WEEK 3

#### Sunday, March 15th

- [16] Revelation 3:14-22 | God was knocking on the hearts of these believers. What might be God asking you to change in your life? Spend time asking him this question.
- [17] Acts 2:1-47 | Over 3,000 believers came to the Lord in one day because of the revival on Pentecost! Pray and ask God to bring about another powerful revival through the Holy Spirit in our day.
- [18] Acts 8:1-25 | Re-read v.21-22. Simon believed the Gospel but his heart was not right before God. Ask the Lord to show you any places where you may need a change of heart.
- [19] Acts 10:1-23 | God was preparing his people for a big change. When was the last time God drastically changed your mind or actions? What might he be asking you to change going forward?
- [20] Acts 10:24-48 | God brought revival to the Gentiles and changed everything! Ask God to help you pray for revival in an unexpected group of people in our current culture.
- [21] Spend time today praying for revival to come in your own heart, in Antioch, in our nation, and in the world.

### WEEK 4

#### Sunday, March 22nd

- [23] 2 Chron. 7:14 | Spend time reflecting on the heart attitudes that bring forth revival and ask the Lord to do it again at Antioch!
- [24] 2 Chron. 14:2-15 | What heart attitudes for revival do you see in this passage?
- [25] 2 Chron. 15:1-8 | What does it look like for you to seek the Lord today?
- [26] 2 Chron. 15:9-19 | Asa put God’s holiness and worship above family connection (v.16). Have you ever been challenged to put God before family?
- [27] Psalm 24:1-6 | What does the psalmist say is a result of seeking the Lord?
- [28] Spend time today praying for revival to come in your own heart, in Antioch, in our nation, and in the world.

### WEEK 5

#### Sunday, March 29th

- [30] 2 Chron. 34 | How does King Josiah prepare the land for revival in this passage?
- [31] 2 Chron. 35:1-18 | The people worshipped the Lord through the Passover celebration. Spend time today worshipping God and thanking Him that He is a God who revives us!
